

Social Work Degree (BA)

Course catalogue and timetable

The degree is divided in four years, with two semesters each year (Autumn term, from the end of September to mid of February and Spring term, from mid of February to the end of June). Each term has 18 weeks of academic activities.

A normal study load includes 30 ECTS per semester or 60 ECTS per academic year. Erasmus and International Mobility Programme students may take any course they want from the catalogue, even if they are taught in different years within the degree, also from the optional course catalogue. You may also choose any course from the other degrees in the faculty (Communication, Social Work, Sociology and Labour Relations). Just check that the timetables of the chosen courses do not overlap.

And once there to “fichas de las asignaturas”. You may also check there other important information as, for instance, exam dates in “Calendario de evaluación”

At the beginning of the academic term, please, check with the professors the main guidelines of each subject and the way it is going to be assessed. Please, take into account:

- FIRST 16 WEEKS EACH TERM: ordinary teaching period for lectures and continuous assessment (there will be different open-question exams, tests, essays to be handed in, tutorial activities, presentations etc. Check at the beginning with your professors)
- END OF WEEK 16th: the student will receive the mark corresponding to the ordinary teaching period.
- WEEK 17th: revision for those students who do not pass the exams in the ordinary period or those students who have to repeat part of the assignments.
- WEEK 18th: resit exams only for those students who failed in the ordinary period

Please, check the English translation in the above reported course catalogue.

All classrooms are located in FES Building, in Campus Miguel de Unamuno and the appropriate number appears in the upper right corner in each year timetable: i.e. **aula 106** is a classroom in the first floor in the FES building. In general all the courses belonging to one year are taught in the same classroom except when it says something different specifically (and it is marked with an *). There could be some changes regarding the classrooms, please check the updates at the beginning of the academic year in September in the faculty web page.

There are different timetables for each semester (which is marked in each timetable at the right as PRIMER SEMESTRE, OR SEGUNDO SEMESTRE, for the winter and spring semesters in each case).

At the end you may find the timetables for the optional courses (optional means that the students following the whole grade in Salamanca may choose among them). You may choose courses from the optional catalogue too.

The professor in charge of each course is written just below the name of the subject. In those cases in which after the name of the course is specified DESDOBLE1 or DESDOBLE2 means that there are two groups and that the lecture is more practical in its content. You may choose the group that better fits your timetable.

There is an alternative timetable for Group 1 for Group 2. You just have to choose between them which fits better to your timetable. The timetable for Group 1 (GRUPO 1) is in the morning and for Group 2 (GRUPO 2) in the afternoon/evening. Some of the courses are taught in both timetables, you just have to choose one of them.

The time slot that is named +FACULTAD is meant to be reserved to cultural activities within the faculty. There will be also cultural activities specifically designed in each course (labeled as COMPLEMENTO DE DOCENCIA).
